Miles per gallon for different engine size

Using the [RAC's vehicle running costs tables](#) for new cars we base our estimations on the miles per gallon for different engine sizes. For the purpose of these estimations we assume a small petrol engine is up to 1.2 litres, a medium petrol engine is up to 1.8 litres, and a large petrol engine is up to 3 litres. We assume a small diesel engine is up to 1.4 litres, a medium diesel engine is 2 to 2.2 litres and a large diesel engine is over 3 litres.
